Overview

The University of Worcester MBA is an internationally-recognised postgraduate qualification in management, aimed at graduates, of any discipline, who have an interest in developing their understanding of the practices of leading a business, have aspirations to run their own business, or are keen to move into general management.

This programme includes on campus and distance learning, whereby students are required to complete the following modules:

1. 20-credit Research Methods module completed on campus
2. 40-credit Dissertation completed through distance learning

After successful completion of the NCC Education Level 7 Diploma in Business Management (120 credits) students can apply directly to the University of Worcester to complete their MBA.

Entry Requirements

Complete 120-credit Level 7 Diploma in Business Management (L7DBM) can fast-track their studies to gain a full MBA from the University of Worcester in the UK.

120 credits from the Level 7 Diploma (L7DBM) will form part of the 180 credit Master of Business Administration (MBA). This means students will only need to complete a 20-credit Research Methods module and a 40-credit dissertation to acquire a full MBA and graduate from the University of Worcester.

Qualification Structure

20-credit Research Methods module - completed at university campus in the UK

The Master of Business Administration (MBA) Top-up Degree has a two-week on campus requirement, which means students will have to travel to the UK to attend the two-week Research Methods classes at the University of Worcester. During these two weeks, students will attend a Research Methods class delivered by University faculty; after which students may leave the UK to complete the dissertation section through distance learning.

40-credit Dissertation - distance learning

Students are required to undertake a single 40-credit master's level dissertation under the supervision of a qualified academic with an appropriate level of expertise in the subject area of the dissertation. A supervisor will work with each student to complete a 10,000-word dissertation through distance learning. The hand-in date of the dissertation will be 6 to 9 months after the start of the course.

Distinctive features of the MBA

The MBA Top-up Degree makes it possible for students to top-up the 120 credits from the NCC Education Level 7 Diploma in Business Management (L7DBM) to the 180 credits required for a full master's degree. The top-up consists of one 20-credit Research Methods module and a 40-credit Dissertation.

Students enrolled onto the University of Worcester MBA Top-up Degree get an opportunity to travel to the UK for the purpose of getting academic training on university campus.
