At the beginning of each module you will watch a video to 'meet' your tutor. They will explain what will be expected of you and what you will learn about during the module.



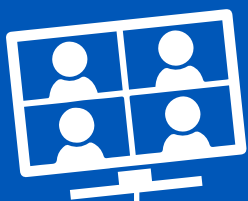
Video Lectures
