Entry Requirements

Students that successfully complete 120 credit Level 7 Diploma in Business Management (L7DBM) can fast-track their studies to gain a full MBA from the University of Plymouth in the UK.

120 credits from the Level 7 Diploma (L7DBM) will form part of the 180 credit Master of Business Administration (MBA). This means students will only need to complete a 60-credit dissertation to acquire a full MBA and graduate from the University of Plymouth.

Qualification Structure

Students are required to undertake a single 60 credit Level-7 dissertation under the supervision of a qualified academic with an appropriate level of expertise in the subject area of the dissertation. The programme consists of a single module: STO712.

On successful completion graduates should have developed:

- 1) skills of critical thinking, reviewing and critically analysis of relevant literature supported through evidence
- 2) an ability to demonstrate a strategic focus in evaluating research evidence

Distinctive features of the MBA

- Dissertation under the supervision of an academic with expertise in the chosen subject area
- Learning support for the programme will be provided through the University of Plymouth DLE, incorporating a variety of digital learning resources and activities (e.g. discussion groups)
- The programme can be studied from any location in the UK or worldwide, with no necessity to travel to Plymouth
- Students studying at distance will have full access to the University of Plymouth's e-library
- The programme is highly flexible, offering two start dates: September and March
