7	 Benefits of using web technologies in supply chain management are correctly identified (3 marks for each). Give credit for any reasonable points, which may include: Share information – this can be two-way and may include updates on progress in the production process, stock levels - location and numbers of coins in stock, matching likely customer demand with available stock etc. Rapid notification - the supplier can send the owner immediate details of any problems which may cause delays, details of when orders have been despatched etc. Increase the speed of processing transactions – EDI can help to ensure that orders are communicated quickly, confirmation of order is received promptly etc. Reduce the cost of handling transactions – electronic communications reduces the costs associated with posting orders and confirmations Reduce errors in entering transaction data – electronic orders don't need to be re-keyed, so the potential for introducing errors is received
