# Sample Assessment

#### Introduction

Lidl Dienstleistung (Lidl) is a privately held company that operates a chain of discount grocery stores. Lidl was founded by businessman Dieter Schwarz in 1973 (Lidl, nd), with the first store opening in Ludwigshafen, in the state of Rhineland-Palatinate, in (at the time, West), Germany - with only three employees and around 500 products. By 1979, there were 30 stores. In the 1980s, Lidl opened 300 stores across Germany; on average each store employing seven people and stocking around 900 product lines. In the 1990s, Lidl opened stores outside Germany, starting with France. During 2007-10, Lidl opened stores in Slovenia, Austria, Bulgaria, Romania and Malta, and Austria. In 1994 Lidl opened its first 10 British stores, and in 2017, Lidl opened its first stores in the United States. Lidl now operates in 32 countries, with over 11,000 stores and employs over 341,000 people globally.

Lidl, like many supermarkets, continues to innovate. In 2022, for example, Lidl launched a smart laundry detergent refill station, aimed at reducing consumer costs and single-use plastics.

This assignment requires you to demonstrate knowledge and skills you have acquired throughout the course of this module, by completing SIX (6) tasks. The total word count is FOUR THOUSAND (4,000) words. Your answers to the tasks must be fully referenced.

To complete the assignment, you will need to research Lidl supermarket, on which to base your responses to the given tasks. You can use web resources to enable you to understand Lidl, although do not limit yourself solely to web-based sources of information. You should also use academic, industry and other reliable sources.

• Step 1: Conduct initial research by exploring the Lidl website and any other useful sources you may find, for example, annual company reports and industry reports.

You are required to answer the SIX (6) tasks below, in relation to Lidl. For each task, you must fully justify your answer using evidence from your research and referencing module material.

## Task 1 - 15 Marks

Investigate how Lidl's organisation structure has evolved since the first store opening in 1973.

Word target = 600 words

#### Task 2 - 15 Marks

Discuss the key characteristics of Lidl's management control system. Word target = 600 words

#### Task 3 - 15 Marks

In 2022, Lidl launched a pilot smart laundry detergent refill station, aimed at reducing consumer costs and single-use plastics. Evaluate how Lidl may monitor performance of this initiative by creating a balanced scorecard.

Word target = 600 words

#### **Task 4 - 20 Marks**

Using Henri Fayol's FIVE (5) functions of management, analyse how Lidl may manage its operations. Your analysis should cover all FIVE (5) functions.

Word target = 800 words

#### **Task 5 - 15 Marks**

Using the Cultural Web model, analyse the organisational culture of Lidl. Your analysis should cover all SIX (6) elements of the Cultural Web.

Word target = 600 words

#### **Task 6 - 20 Marks**

Analyse the characteristics, advantages and disadvantages of Lidl's structure.

Word target = 800 words
